## NORTH STAINLEY OIL CLUB

## RETIREMENT OF JACKIE DONALDSON

Jackie has indicated that she will not be standing for re-election to the Parish Council in May. Jackie was thanked for having served on the Parish Council for 8 years.

This means that there will be a vacancy for a new Councillor to serve on the Council. Nomination forms (which are available from the Clerk) to be appointed through the electoral process have to be submitted to Harrogate Borough Council by noon on 4th April. If there are insufficient candidates (i.e. less than 7 people standing for election) then the Parish Council will be free to 'co-opt' or choose someone to fill any remaining vacancies.

## WATERMILL POND



Preparations are underway to try and tackle the 'crassula helmsii' weed problem in the small pond with the watermill in.

The fish in the pond will be netted and transferred to a new location, before a sheet is put over the pond. This will block out the light and hopefully kill the weed, although it is likely to take several months to work. It is hoped that this will take place at the beginning of April.

The Parish Council has been concerned about **disturbances** in the village during the past two weekends, including dangerous incidents such as putting a picnic table in the middle of the main road. Information has been passed to North Yorkshire Police who will be carrying out additional patrols in the village. Please report any suspicious activity or groups to the Police (call 101). Parents are asked to monitor their children's behaviour and whereabouts.
