This report shows that the Parish Council finished the year £993.80 under-budget. This is mainly because of unexpectedly low expenditure on maintenance items.

- * Grasscutting The budget included provision for 16 cuts, but only 11 were charged for.
- * Play areas The Council was £373.20 under budget as there were no significant repairs required. It is suggested that this under-spend is added to the £1500 of ring-fenced funds for future playground costs (see balance analysis report).
- * Caretaker Farm & Land Services resigned at the end of 2014, but had not carried out any work since July 2014.

Expenditure on the Clerk was significantly over-budget due to the administration caused by having to respond to Freedom of Information and Subject Access requests made by a member of the public at the start of 2015.
