This is to pay for increased spending on maintenance, including on West Tanfield play area.

### SPEEDING IN WEST TANFIELD & NOSTERFIELD

Hambleton Community Safety Partnership has sent the results of speed checks it recently carried at 3 locations in West Tanfield and 1 in Nosterfield.

West (nearside) – 36mph		
East (farside) – 35mph		
East (nearside) – 33mph		
West (farside) – 38mph		
Heading out of village – 30mph

West (farside) – 41mph		

Perceived speeds can often be higher than actual recordings which seems to be the case in this parish as the findings are all in line with the expected results and so no further action will be taken.
