The Parish Council met on 16th April 2012 and considered a number of items.

TRAFFIC CALMING

It is hoped that a new policy, currently being considered by North Yorkshire County Council, would allow parishes (or groups of parishes) to use a mobile Vehicle Activated Sign in their areas.

This would mean that the signs could be used to target where speeding vehicles are a problem. They would be sited in these areas for a few weeks, before being moved on to other sites.

There is currently no timescale for when the new policy may be drawn up or implemented, but the Parish Council will continue to pursue this as a potentially achievable method of further traffic calming.

PLANNING APPLICATION



The Parish Council agreed that it has no objections to a proposal for an extension at Tarn Cottage, Nosterfield.

VACANCIES ON THE PARISH COUNCIL

There are currently two vacancies on the Parish Council, one for the East Tanfield ward, the other for West Tanfield.

The Parish Council considered the latest consultation on the **Minerals and Waste Development Framework.** It was agreed that on this occasion it did not wish to make any comments to North Yorkshire County Council.
