PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT

The Parish Council has considered a number of planning applications and development issues at recent meetings:

- The Parish Council agreed with residents' concerns about overlooking issues resulting from proposals to extend Stonehaven, Nosterfield and also commented on the lack of detail in the application. This follows on from concerns about static caravans being located at the property.
- The Parish Council has no objections to a proposed new fence at West Tanfield Primary School.
- The Parish Council has also objected to proposals for a joinery workshop at Roselea in Thornborough as it does not consider the site to be in a suitable location for such a proposal.
- Applications for an extension to Tarn Cottage in Nosterfield, construction of a slurry storage tank at North Tanfield Farm and felling of a tree at Bramley House in West Tanfield have been approved.
