Tanfield Parish Council NEWSLETTER

The Parish Council met in April, May & June and considered a number of items.



For the past few years the Parish Council, Nosterfield Quarry and local businesses and sponsors have worked to put on a bonfire and fireworks display each November.

The 2012 event raised £199.72 for West Tanfield Memorial Hall but cost £931.62 to put on, with the majority of the costs covered by sponsorship.

It is thought that bad weather put off a lot of people from coming.

It will soon be time to decide whether to put on an event in 2013 and so the Parish Council would like to hear your views. Do you enjoy the event and want to come to another one in 2013? Do you think that there might be other ways of raising money for the Memorial Hall?

PARISH CARETAKER

SEWERAGE ISSUES

Problems with the sewerage system at Nosterfield and Thornborough were discussed with Yorkshire Water representatives at the Council's April meeting.

Thornborough – Yorkshire Water are hoping to allocate funding so that the sewer between Thornborough and West Tanfield can be replaced in the near future. It is not known when this will happen yet though. The pipe continues to burst on a regular basis.

Nosterfield - The problems here are ongoing and so the Parish Council has decided to escalate this matter by contacting the Environment Agency and William Hague MP to ask for help. This is in addition to maintaining regular contact with Yorkshire Water.

Yorkshire Water has agreed to pay for the parish caretaker to reinstate Nosterfield Village Green. The Parish Council has welcomed this offer, but made it clear that the damage should not be allowed to recur if large vehicles are used during future pumping operations.

It would be helpful if residents who experience problems, or who notice burst pipes could report them to Yorkshire Water (call 0800 57 35 53) and then pass the reference number on to the Parish Council.

This will help the Parish Council and Yorkshire Water to compile a central database of all the issues in this area.

VACANCY ON THE PARISH COUNCIL

There remains a vacancy on the Parish Council following the resignation of Jim Beadle who has moved out of the parish.
