LOCAL DEVELOPMENT FRAMEWORK

The Parish Council has responded to a consultation by Hambleton District Council about proposals for future development in the area.

The Parish Council has suggested that the current policy of only allowing new houses to be built in towns and larger villages should be scrapped and that *appropriate and proportionate* development could be allowed in smaller villages, such as Nosterfield and Thornborough.
