The Parish Council met in October, November & December 2014 to consider a number of items of business.

SUPERFAST BROADBAND



Superfast North Yorkshire is going to be bringing superfast broadband to West Tanfield in the next few months (installed by OpenReach). To register your interest in receiving this service or find out more go to:

There are currently no plans to bring a mainstream service to Nosterfield or Thornborough, so the Parish Council is looking at an option which uses a radio signal beamed from Sutton Bank. This is then distributed wirelessly to subscribing properties. It's completely independent of BT and the phone system and appears a very attractive option. Key features are overleaf or on the Council's website, but basically it costs £99 to install (plus £49 for their router if you choose that) then a monthly payment of £15 for 10mbs, £20 for 20mbs or £25 for 30mbs. If you wish, you can also transfer your phone number to use as an internet phone for a further £6 per month (saving your monthly line rental charge).

15 users are required in each village for it to be viable. If you would be interested then please contact the Clerk whose details are below.

COMMON LAND

There are a number of areas of registered common land in the parish, including Nosterfield Village Green, Thornborough play area and the riverside at West Tanfield. All of these areas are owned by Tanfield Estate.

The Parish Council is working to regularise maintenance arrangements for those areas on which its play equipment is sited. It has been agreed that the Parish Council will not take on any further responsibility or costs by maintaining additional areas.

2015/16 BUDGET

The Parish Council has agreed its budget for the next financial year. It can be viewed online at:

www.tanfieldparishcouncil.btck.co.uk/Financials It has been agreed that the Council needs to increase the precept (money collected for it through Council Tax) by £500.

If more than 5 people decide to stand for election to the Parish Council in May then Hambleton District Council will charge it for the cost of holding a poll, which could be up to $\pounds 2,000$ (which can be paid over four years). The Parish Council has no choice but to budget for this possible expense.
