


GRANDSIRE DOUBLES SHOWING THE EFFECT OF BOBS AND SINGLES



FOLLOW THE METHOD IN THE LEFT HAND COLUMNS

LOOK AT THE FIRST BOB

3 bells are affected by a Bob

The 2nd bell plain hunting now double dodges 4-5 Down becoming a working bell

The 3rd bell instead of dodging 4-5 Up immediately makes 3rds and becomes the Hunt bell plain hunting like the treble until another Bob is called

The 5th bell about to dodge 4-5 Down will now double dodge 4-5 Up

The 4th bell is unaffected.

A SINGLE

4 bells are affected at a Single.

The bell that's plain hunting double dodges 4-5 Down becoming a working bell exactly the same as a

The bell the treble takes off the lead makes 2nds and becomes the hunt bell

The bell about to dodge 4-5 down double dodges 4-5 Up

The bell that would have dodged 4-5 Up makes Long 3rds, that's 4 blows in 3rds place
