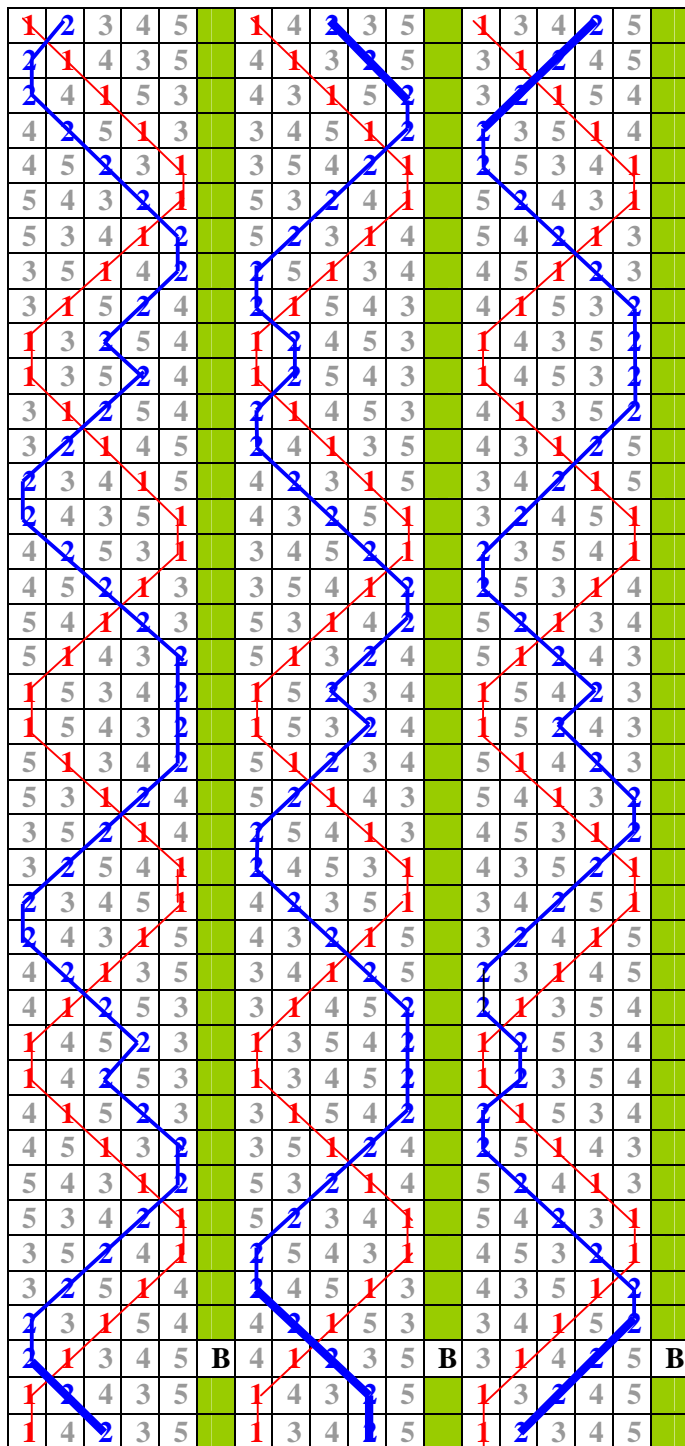


BOB DOUBLES A TOUCH



EXPLANATION OF TERMS USED

Plain Hunt – Means go out to the back, two blows at the back and move back to the lead and you lead twice. Only the treble bell does this. See the **Red line** opposite following the treble and see how it “hunts” throughout the method.

Make Seconds – Means you lead twice, ring in seconds place twice always over the treble and lead again twice.

Dodge 3-4 down – Moving from the back in 5ths place down to 3rds place. You then go back into 4ths place and then continue down to the lead. You will be doing this moving around or “dodging” as we call it with the bell dodging 3-4 up.

Dodge 3-4 up, move up from the lead to 4ths place, then move down to thirds place, then up to fourths place and on up to the back

Long 5ths or 4 blows behind – Exactly what it says. Ring 4 times in 5ths place over bells dodging in 3-4.

Bobs. In order to extend the length of a method the conductor can call a Bob at certain points during the method. These Calls are made when the treble is in 2nds place and about to lead. When a call is made the cycle of work changes. What to do when a Bob is called and what comes next is explained at the bottom of the page.

Make the Bob – If you are going to dodge 3-4 Up and a Bob is called, you “Make the Bob”. Instead of dodging 3-4 up you get to 4ths place and ring your bell twice in 4ths. You then go back to the lead as follows: 1 2 3 4 4 3 2 1. Your next work in the cycle is 4 blows at the back.

Run out, Run in or Unaffected – The bell about to make 2nds at a Bob will, instead of making 2nds runs or plain hunts out to the back, back to the front and makes 2nds next time. The bell about to dodge 3-4 down misses out the dodge, plain hunts down to the lead, hunt to the back and dodges 3-4 down next time. The bell making 4 blows behind is the only one unaffected. It carries on as normal.
