### THE COMMUNITY GARDEN - THE PLANS ARE CHANGING

For some years now the Friends of St Catherine's Church has been supporting and assisting financially with plans to create a Community Garden around the Church entrance. The Church is a listed building and everything has to be approved by the Diocesan Advisory Committee and by English Heritage. Both these organisations are in favour of the scheme but have requested changes to the plans that were submitted. This is in order to reduce the impact on the present churchyard by moving a smaller number of headstones. New outline plans have now been approved and we are now in the process of proceeding with full plans which will then be submitted for approval. Once these are agreed the full details will be made available to all the community.

It has also been decided to rename the project to reflect the current plans. The aim of the project is to make the graveyard more community friendly but its prime purpose is a Churchyard so the scheme is now "Churchyard Enhancement."
