A message from our new Rector:

I am very much looking forward to moving to the Potteries to join you. I have happy memories of Lichfield Diocese as I was ordained in the Cathedral and was a curate in Stafford. Then I moved to Worcestershire working in a number of parishes and as a chaplain to people at work in factories, offices and shops.

It's an exciting time to join the Hanley Team Ministry with so many opportunities and possibilities. I hope my previous experience and the skills I've learned will fit with at least some of them. I believe strongly in doing 'traditional church' well enjoying good worship that gives God glory, as well as sharing God's love in the fellowship of being part of a regular congregation. I also believe, from my present parish and my work as a chaplain with many people who don't come to church, that we need to find ways of attracting people to faith that fit with modern life.

More widely, I've been asked to work with the business community in Hanley and with the new team rector of Stoke (who is also coming from Worcester Diocese) and the area dean to raise the profile of the Church in the city. Clearly, this must be balanced with being the priest and pastor of the local churches I'm responsible for, which I want to sustain and build up, as well as my wider responsibility as team rector in leading and supporting the hugely diverse and talented staff team and sharing in the ministry to the other churches in the team parish. Pray for me!

It's important to say I don't come with fixed ideas about what I might do and please don't read into what I've said to mean that I will favour any particular area of work over another. I come to listen and learn and to respond and discern to what it seems to God and to me to be the right way forward. My guide will be to respond to people's needs in God's love and to make a difference to individuals and the wider community by sharing the transforming power of that love shown in Christ's death on the cross and rising again to new life. We will be celebrating that in Holy week and Easter very soon after I arrive.

I hope to move to the vicarage in Birches Head at the end of March. My son, Alasdair, is in his final year at school so will be staying in Worcestershire with his mum. I hope he will visit me as often as he can, but then he hopes to gain his independence and go to university, so maybe then he will appear only rarely! I hope to see you at my licensing service with the Bishop of Lichfield at St. Matthew's on Saturday 8 April and at the services and activities for Holy Week and Easter that follow immediately after. It's going to be a busy but, I hope, uplifting time.
