Panda Playgroup Autumn Term Newsletter 2013

<u>Welcome</u>

I would like to start by welcoming all of our new starters, we are pleased to have new faces here at Panda, they have all settled in very well so far. It has been a very busy settling in period at Pandas with the introduction of a new Committee Chair, Panda Leader and lots of new Panda's joining the family. Thank you to parents for understanding and assisting Mel the new leader with meeting needs for the playgroup and information required for the children.

All the staff at Pandas are looking forward to an exciting term ahead with lots of new ideas for the children following their visit to the Early Years Centre of Excellence, Huddersfield. Some of these have already been put into practice and the children are very much enjoying the new activities and enjoying the presentation and set up of their toys and equipment. They have also found great interest in painting with broccoli and cabbage leaves.

Heating

This is now in full use and the staff are doing all they can to ensure the room is a comfortable temperature with the weather turning colder. However if you can ensure you send a cardigan/jumper for your child we can ensure they are kept warm. As the cold creeps upon us children need to have a hat, scarf and gloves to ensure we can allow children to have outside time, something which they very much enjoy. All clothing should be labelled.

What have we been learning through play?

Panda team have been developing the areas of learning indoor and outdoor play, we encourage children to explore and learn through their own play. We are hoping to establish areas whereby children can explore and enjoy as well as learn and respect the toys. The children have been learning different songs at registration time, a copy of these have been sent home. We will be continuing these songs as part of their daily routine making allowances for their development needs. We have been playing with lentils, pouring, measuring, filling bottles, funnelling, all the while enjoying learning about harvest.

Outing

On 22nd October during our Panda Plus session we are going on a short walk to learn about our surrounding environment, we will be taking our magnifying glasses for the children to look at their findings closer. We would really appreciate any volunteers to help with the walk, please speak to Mel if you would be available to help us out.

Phonics Fun

The children have been having lots of fun with phonics through singing songs, rhyming and repeating their sounds. This is encouraging further development of their language using senses.

Can you help?

We are seeking resources to build up the learning areas, this term we are looking for: Pumice Stones, Lufers, Wooden Spoons, Sponges.

We are also looking for kitchen roll tubes to make Christmas crackers. Also, any old shelving/shoe racks etc..
