Dear members of Newton Community Council,

I would like to invite you all to the opening of the new section of National Cycle Network through the Hopetoun Estate. The opening event is to take place on the afternoon of the 20<sup>th</sup> September at 2.30pm at the Abercorn Church Hall on the Hopetoun Estate (please see attached map for location).

We will be inviting members of West Lothian Council, community councils and residents from the local area as well as members of Abercorn Church to the event. We will also invite staff from Hopetoun Estate, Hopetoun Trust and press representatives to cover the opening in the local newspaper. In all there should be around 35-40 attendees.

The proposed format is that groups of cyclists will cycle from Blackness and from the Hopetoun main gate and meet at Abercorn. It is anticipated that Lord Hopetoun will give a short speech and cut a ribbon draped over the new access gate at Abercorn in celebration of the completed path project. We will then retire to the hall for tea and cake.

Sustrans will be extremely grateful for your attendance at this celebratory event. We hope that the above arrangements are acceptable to you.

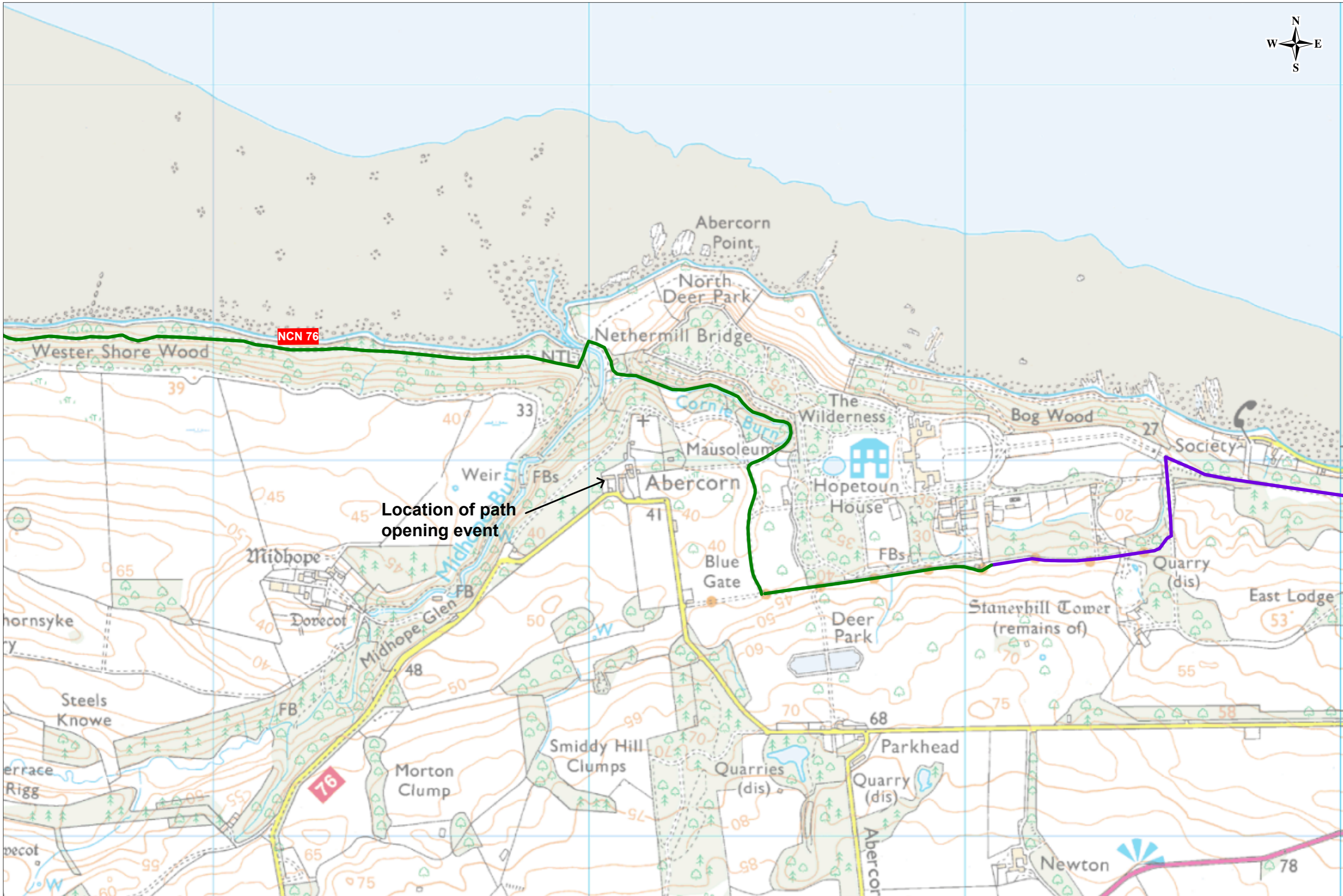
