2015/16 BUDGET



The Parish Council has agreed its budget for the next financial year. It has agreed to keep the precept (money raised for it through Council Tax) the same, at $\pounds 6,223$, for the sixth consecutive year. 2015 GRASSCUTING

North Yorkshire County Council is going to reduce the amount that it pays Parish Councils for cutting grass verges. In the past the County Council has paid parishes who choose to cut the grass verges, instead of doing it themselves.

From 2015 the County Council will only contribute towards the cost of cutting visibility splays at certain road junctions. It means that this Parish Council will only receive \pounds 50.49 (compared to \pounds 703.45 in 2014). Councillors felt that this was an inordinate reduction, but has taken it in to account when setting its budget.
