VACANCY ON THE PARISH COUNCIL

SAWLEY VILLAGE GREEN

The Parish Council owns Sawley Village Green and is responsible for its maintenance and management.

A new policy has been agreed which gives a general permission for events to be held on the Green - this is in addition to the casual usage enjoyed by local residents on a day-to-day basis. The policy covers all private and community events including weddings, country fairs and sports days.

Permission is given, subject to:

- The Parish Council being notified at least 14 days before, using a special form available on the Council's website or from the Clerk.
- A risk assessment being carried out.
- Organisers considering whether they need to insure their event as they are not covered by the Council's policy.
