Aquilegia Downy Mildew As your aquilegias waken up this spring, please do keep an eye on them for signs of Aquilegia Downy Mildew, a very real threat to the Aquilegia (granny bonnets) so common in our cottage gardens. The holder of the national collection, Carrie Thomas of Touchwood Plants has put together a useful guide to the symptoms and possible control of this infection, typified by yellow patches on the leaves followed by fluffy white growth on the underside of the leaves, and distorted flowers.
