"Mervyn Taylor was one of our Flower & Pot Plant judges from at least 1992 - 2008, I say 'at least' because records prior to that were sketchy, to say the least. He never seemed to age, and from 'stewarding' him can say that he was always willing to share his knowledge and explain things as in the beginning I always seemed to be asking 'why that' instead of 'this'. When I stopped stewarding and became Show Secretary he continued to be helpful, advising me as to what other organisations paid the judges, and helping to refine the schedule. He moved from Reading to Tilehurst in his later years and ceased Judging, but always kept in touch."

Mervyn's family kindly requested that collection at his funeral be divided between the THA and the Tilehurst Allotment Society. committee will consider how best this beguest can be used in Mervyn's memory.
