# HASSOCKS VILLAGE LOTTERY CLUB

- Proceeds from the Lottery will be shared equally between the member community groups who provide the volunteers necessary to operate the lottery.
- The Lottery shall be conducted in accordance with the Gambling Act 2005, under licence from Mid Sussex District Council.
- Applications for membership of the Hassocks Village Lottery Club will open from October 2013 for the membership period of December 2013 – November 2014.
- Membership is open to all Hassocks residents or users of Hassocks Amenities.
- Membership for the current term closes on 7<sup>th</sup> December 2013.
- The first draw will be on the 20th December 2013, future draws will be on the fourth Friday of each month.
- Payments by cheque must be received and cleared by the 19<sup>th</sup> of the month to be eligible for that month's draw.
- The draw will be held monthly and all numbers paid for that month will be entered.
- Membership costs £12 per annum which entitles members to one unique number which is entered in each of the 12 monthly draws.
- Any one member may purchase up to four numbers.
- Numbers are allocated by the Promoter and held until the member withdraws their membership.
- Payment will be delivered by cheque to the winning members not more than 5 working days after a draw.
- The results will be published on the HAA website, in the Talk About and at the Hassocks Parish Council Offices.
- Prizes will be allocated to a total of 40% of the funds collected each month as follows:
  - o First prize 60% of the prize allocation
  - Second prize 40% of the prize allocation
- <u>Example:</u> 500 numbers in the monthly draw would yield £300 to promoters and £200 for prizes. First prize would be £120 and second prize £80. This could produce an annual income for distribution amongst the participant community groups totalling £3,600 or £1,200 each before related expenses.

- Light Up Hassocks consists of a small group of volunteers dedicated to providing Christmas lights for our Hassocks high street and organising an Christmas street festival. Our aim is to help local businesses and keep our high street alive during the winter months, protecting our unique community spirit.
