






Indulgence Evening -

Persons wishing to stand for election as **Parish Councillors** must be nominated by two parishioners and can stand for election at the next local election. Elections for the **Parish Council** take place at the same time as elections for the CWAC councillors. If there are more candidates for the Parish Council than vacancies the formal election procedures have to be followed and parishioners will be required to vote. If there are sufficient vacancies on the

Council the relevant candidates will be deemed to be elected unopposed.
