Sporting activities at Manley Village Hall




Booking


Manley Village Hall is available for hire day or evening. It has a fully licensed bar and can accommodate between 80-120 people. It is equipped with a fitted kitchen.

In the first instance you can book the hall by contacting Lisa Underhill on 01928 740210 or by speaking to the bar staff at the hall.

You will be sent a booking contract with conditions of hire and the hire rate, currently £8ph -daytime,£10ph -evening and £15ph for Fri and Sat evening hire.

A deposit will be asked for in advance which will be refunded after, but within 1 week of the hire. The full hire charge will be payable before the hire period.
