Peasmarsh Memorial Hall Refurbishment Project

Before the next Periodical is published our third and final stage bid for Big Lottery Funding for this project will have been submitted.

It is difficult for anyone who has not been involved to recognise the enormous amount of work which has gone into all three stages – but in particular into stage 3.

We have been really fortunate in that we have been able to call on steering group members, advisers and other professionals with extensive expertise, and that all these have been willing to give so freely of their time and efforts.

All being well, we shall know the result by August, and if the news is good building work should start by October.

We are working with the Recreation Ground Committee to provide suitable alternative accommodation for the present users of the hall while the work is being done.
