Watch out for ROAD CLOSURES !

The County Highways Department is planning a number of road repair jobs in and around Peasmarsh in the next few weeks. On Sept 21st and Oct 5th Fishmarket Road will be closed from 7.pm until 6.am the next morning. On October 22nd the A 268 will be closed between Four Oaks and Bixley Lane. On Oct. 9th Ferry Road will be closed at the level crossing from 1.am to 4.am on the 10^{th} . Between Oct 17th and the 24th work will be taking place on the A268 between Four Oaks and Peasmarsh. It appears from the map as if this stops at Kitchenour Lane but we have not been able to confirm this.
