East Sussex County Council has been awarded funding from National Grid's Warm Homes Fund aimed at helping people in fuel poverty. The funding is to enabling the installation of at least 100 new gas central heating systems free of charge to vulnerable residents such as older people or families on low income. Recent Power Cut

On Sunday 29th June a large number of households in Peasmarsh suffered a power cut which lasted about an hour or so. However, some households were without power for up to 24 hours and according to UK Power Network they should have received an automatic set payment if they were without power for 12 hours or longer. If yours was one of these households and you have not yet received compensation then ring their Care Team on 0800 0284 587 to see if you are entitled to compensation.
