### **Community Speed Watch**

In September 2017 a Vehicle Activated Sign (VAS) was installed to monitor traffic entering the village from the direction of Rye. When activated it records the date, time and speed of vehicles. To date it has recorded between 40,000 and 45,000 vehicles a month and of these around 1200 a day are travelling in excess of 36 mph with some as high as 65 mph. Since forming in September 2014 the Peasmarsh Speed Watch group had been running regular monitoring sessions but in June 2017 had to stop due to a lack of volunteers. Because of budget cuts and other pressures speeding traffic is now a low priority for the police and they are more reliant than ever on Community Speed Watch groups to help fill the gap
