On Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> of May 2019 voting will be taking place to elect your District and Parish Councillors for the next four years. **If you have not already registered to vote then you will need to do so by 9**<sup>th</sup> **April 2019** and if you wish to stand for election then nomination papers must be submitted on any working day from 10am to 4pm between Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> March and 4pm Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> April. They need to be submitted by hand to the Town Hall Bexhill-on-Sea. Any nomination forms sent by post will be rejected.
