No further action will be taken by Rother District Council or the other organisations involved, until similar projects in 3 other villages in the district have been completed,

A lot of hard work is going into finalising the Big Lottery Fund Community Buildings stage two application. Grey Metcalf is heading the working party which is completing the form to be submitted to the BLF **this month**. If this and the 3rd stage bid is successful, work can commence on refurbishing the hall to meet the needs of the community in the 21st Century. Clubs, classes and societies will run **again** locally for Peasmarsh residents. In the meantime we are working to attract further group usage of the hall.
