**Individual Electoral Registration
(IER)**

**The way you register to vote has
changed. The new registration system is
called 'Individual Electoral Registration'**

Everyone is responsible for registering
themselves. Under the old system the 'head
of every household' could register everyone
who lived at their address.

You can now register online at

www.gov.uk/register-to-vote

If you are a postal or proxy voter you must
register under the new IER system or you
will automatically lose your right to use this
method of voting.

***Make sure you are eligible to vote in the
elections next May.***

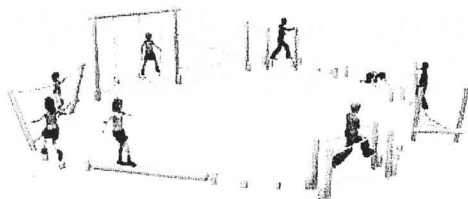


LOOKING AHEAD.
