The Maltings

The Amicus Horizon housing redevelopment at The Maltings has begun with the complete demolition and removal of the existing buildings. The redevelopment is expected to take approximately 18 months to complete and the contractors permitted hours are between 8am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturday. Work is not permitted on Sundays, Bank and Public holidays. Please be aware that there will be heavy goods vehicles in and around The Maltings and surrounding area during these hours. Although Westridge Construction is committed to keeping the noise and disturbance to a minimum there will inevitably be some noise and disturbance particularly during the demolition phase
