Every six years a new Roll is prepared and those on the previous Roll are informed so that they can re-apply. Those on the Roll are usually 'habitual worshippers' at All Saints Church, Beckley and/or St. Peter & St. Paul Parish Church Peasmarsh. If you were on the last Roll but sickness, temporary absence or another essential reason has prevented you worshipping at Church in person over the last six months you may still enrol but have to mention the reason for absence on the form.
