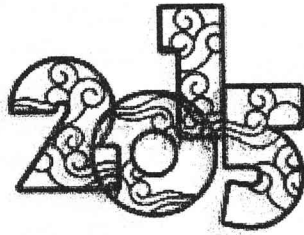

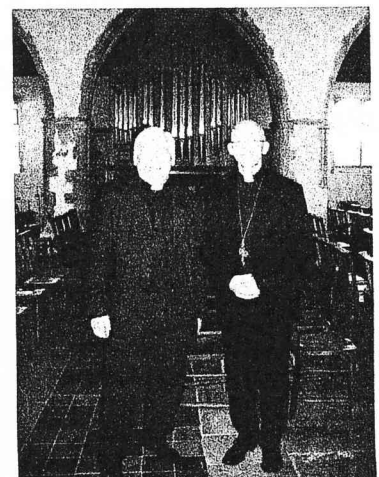
Get Snap Happy in 2015 **Do you like to take photographs?**

Peasmarsh Playspace

Several times over the past 3 years we have published items about the children's playspace in the PP, asking for volunteers to come forward to assist with repairs and replacements, and to increase the numbers on the Recreation Ground Committee.

The response has been absolutely nil.

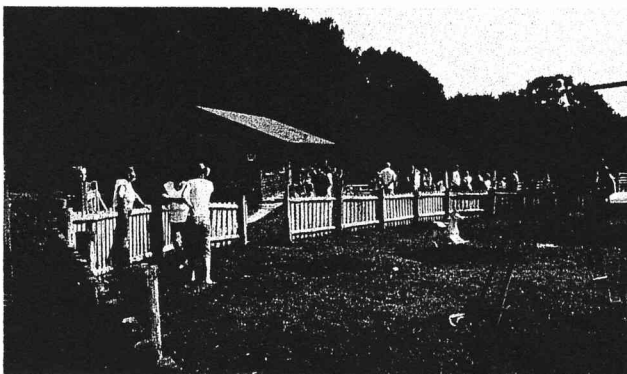
In June 2014 the annual RoSPA inspection drew our attention to several items in need of replacement, and the site is in need of considerable repair work to remain safe, if it is to be kept open.

As an immediate measure the RGC has obtained a quote for replacement parts for those items at highest risk, in order to keep the playspace open. Without any labour charges this amounts to £5,000 before VAT.

The Parish Council is offering some funds towards this expense, and it may be possible to seek other grant funding from charitable sports bodies, but we can only expect grant funding if we are also making an effort to raise funds ourselves, in the same way as the excellent team responsible for the original construction of this playspace did.

With an enthusiastic and energetic team dedicated to the playspace we could work to fix the most urgent problems, while exploring the best way to build a more modern playspace with the additional option of some outdoor adult exercise frames, and to get the whole village involved in the project, and in raising the required funds.
