Phone and Internet Problems

Over the past few months some residents have been suffering from intermittent crackling on their telephone lines and also loss of their internet connections. In October 2016 the Parish Council made a formal complaint to BT about these problems and demanded that they address them as a matter of urgency. In response BT stated that a number of problems with the equipment in the local Peasmarsh exchange had been identified and that they would rectify them by the end of December 2016. 313 Bus Service

Do you use this service and would you like to help with a survey on passenger numbers. As you know in May 2016 the Parish Councils of Peasmarsh, Beckley and Northiam agreed to share, for a 12 month trial period, the cost of funding an additional service to run from Northiam to Rye at 9.03 am. The three Parish Councils are very keen to know how well this and all the other 313 service are being used before deciding on further funding and also to help us in discussions we will have with East Sussex County Council on any decisions they wish to take regarding the future of the 313 service. You can be of great help by making a note of any journey you take together with the number of passengers travelling on that service, where you boarded and alighted and the date and time of your journey. Rye Area Children's Community Choir (Advance notice for February)

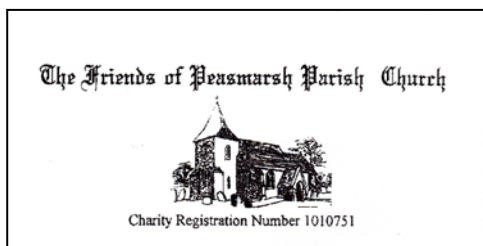
