### **Hearing Testing - Thursday 13<sup>th</sup>**

East Sussex Hearing Resource Centre, a registered charity working in partnership with Adult Social Care will be providing a no charge mobile information and advice service for Deaf, deafened and hard of hearing people living in Peasmarsh.

The mobile unit will be in Jempson's Car Park from 10.30am – 3.30pm on Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> July 2017. The bus is accessible to wheelchair users, and representatives from both the East Sussex Hearing Resource Centre and Adult Social Care will be available to provide individual information and advice on all aspects of hearing loss.

The vehicle, which is funded by the Big Lottery, is equipped to offer demonstrations of assistive equipment and hearing screening tests (if time permits).
