The Steering Group has recently submitted an application to the COMMUNITY SUSTAINABLE ENERGY PROGRAMME. If successful this will bring in a grant of 50% of the cost of the installation of heat pumps and solar panels for the refurbished hall and bring Peasmarsh to the standard of energy-saving which would qualify for the list of local halls with green technologies RVA expects to promote, advertising them in its hall information pack.

Meanwhile work continues to complete the stage 3 application for BLF funding which it is hoped will be ready for submission by the end of this month.

RUBBISH!

Most of us agree that Rother's waste collection system works quite well now, with residents using their wheelybins and putting them out for emptying on the designated days.

Sadly, there have been complaints that just one or two residents are using the public roadside litterbins to dispose of their household waste on a regular basis. This applies particularly to the bins at the Recreation Ground and at the Bus Stop closest to The Maltings.

If your wheelybin is not big enough for your waste, you can apply to Rother for a larger one.

Please do not use the roadside bins which are not intended for that purpose.
