The 3rd Rye 10 Road Race will be taking place this year on Sunday 25 May from 10 am.

The race will start from the entrance to Jempson's Car Park which is open for runners and supporters from 8.30 am to 2pm and the 10 mile route is via Tanhouse Lane turning into Starvecrow Lane, then into Moore's Lane, along Furnace Lane turning right at Calveslodge Wood into Horseshoe Lane, then back to Starvecrow Lane and the finish will again be at Jempson's Car Park.

Tanhouse Lane from Jempson's Car Park to the junction of School Lane will be closed to traffic for approximately 30 minutes between 9.45 and 10.15

We are currently contacting those people who acted as marshalls and manned water stations previously but we will still need people to help so it's not too late to volunteer. This is an exciting project to become involved in - plenty of fresh air and the excitement of watching 300 plus runners from near and far pounding the lanes of Peasmarsh. Last years race raised over £800 towards the upkeep of the Memorial Hall and the hope is that there will be even more runners this year - please turn out to cheer the runners on, or volunteer to help to make sure this is an even bigger success -
