The summer sports days sponsored by Peasmarsh Parish Council and run by Bourne's Sports Association every Wednesday in August were highly successful. All sessions were structured so that all children of primary school age could take part in the activities. Each of the sessions attracted 20 or more children and the activities ranged from football to a big bug hunt in the woods beside the Recreation Ground. It is hoped to run something similar again in August next year.

In October Bourne's Sports Association will be running a 2 day soccer school for 5-13 year old boys and girls on Thursday 26th and Friday 27th. The cost is £30 per child and Peasmarsh Parish Council has negotiated a 50% reduction on this price for children from Peasmarsh.
