Peasmarsh Village Society (P.V.S)

In November 2012 the majority of the committee members felt that the PVS had ceased to serve a useful function for the village and that the time had come to wind it up. A minority of the committee members including the then chairperson, Mrs Sandra Farley felt that it could and should continue to function.

All of the major officers resigned following the November meeting including the treasurer, Robin Dent. The new committee has never deleted Robin Dent's authority as a signatory of the PVS accounts in which there was a balance of just under £400, nor has the new committee appointed a new signatory. In the light of this apparent inactivity it is suggested the PVS be formally wound up and the remaining credit balance transferred to Peasmarsh Recreation Ground Committee for the Playspace project
