The FAW is committed to providing good quality football in a safe environment. The FAW Code of Conduct and good practice sets standards for clubs, coaches, Players and Parents involved in football. It has been developed to improve standards of good practice and protect the welfare and well being of all those involved in the game, particularly young players themselves.

PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT

- Remember that children play sport for their enjoyment and not yours.
- Encourage children to participate do not force them.
- Avoid pressurising your child about winning or losing.
- Remember that the club's coaches take a long term approach to your child's football development.
- Encourage children to play within the rules/laws of the game.
- Remember children learn best by example. Applaud and encourage all players, and applaud good play by the opposition.
- Show respect to your child's coach and match officials.
- Never publicly criticise your child, the coach or other players.
- Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities.
- Do not question decisions made by the coaches and match officials. Show appreciation for coaches and officials. Without them your child could not participate.
- Do not coach from the touchline because it sends out conflicting messages and confuses the children
