CALLS TO POLICE

During period 31st January to 28th February 2017, PSoS received **516** calls to incidents in Alloa;

- Beat A01 – **129** calls received for area leading from town towards Cambus.
- Beat A02 – **170** calls received for area behind Tesco out towards Clackmannan
- Beat A03 – **140** calls for town centre
- Beat A04 – **77** calls received for area leading out towards Tullibody

Calls range from public looking for advice from Police, member of the public reporting drug related issues, disturbance, road traffic offences and concern for person. Not all calls result in a report(s) having to be submitted.

17 calls to old St Johns Primary, Grange Road. Developer contacted and building further secured. Additional patrols being conducted when possible.

RECORDED CRIME

During period 31st January to 28th February 2017

- **111** crimes recorded
- **54** undetected
- **57** detected

Detection rate **51%**, with a large number of undetected incidents marked as having enquiries still ongoing.



Incidents of note;

- 27/02/17, an 18 year old local male stole a house key and then stole a vehicle from an address in Gaberston Avenue. Vehicle traced along with male, who will appearing from Police custody at court on 01/03/17.
- 26/02/17, a male was robbed within his home address in Ashley Terrace, by a 26 year old local male. The male has not yet been traced, however extensive enquiry is ongoing to trace him.
- 07/02/17, a 32 year old local male appeared at court in relation to a robbery in Engelen Drive, committed the previous day.
- 04/02/17, enquiries still ongoing in relation to an adult purchasing alcohol for underage youths in town centre. 40 year old adult identified along with youths.
- 31/01/17 – 01/02/17, positive line of enquiry still ongoing regarding thefts around Arns Grove.
- 31/01/17 to 28/02/17, 21 vandalisms recorded across Alloa. 2 detected with enquiries ongoing in relation to others.
- Over same period 9 detected drugs cases.
- 9 assaults reported over period with 2 remaining undetected with enquiry still ongoing.

ANY OTHER COMMUNITY ISSUES

As per last meeting Sergeant Sharkey has been temporarily promoted to Inspector, stationed at Falkirk. She has been replaced by Sergeant Scott Thomson, who can be contacted on the usual phone number or via e-mail

Parking in town centre still continues to be an ongoing issue. Additional patrols being conducted and significant number of tickets issued, although numbers of vehicles appear to be reducing. Police enforcement to continue for the foreseeable future.



The additional patrols that were conducted at the end of January, start of February, regarding anti-social behaviour and drug related issues appear to have had an effect on the persons hanging about the area. These patrols will continue.

Skate Park near Bowmar Centre, Alloa, lights repaired, however due to weather and unknown other issues youths appear not to be using it as much as previous.

E-mail and phone scams still ongoing, increasing use of I-Tune vouchers.
