INTRODUCTION

CALLS TO POLICE

During period 29th March to 31st May 2016, PSoS received 1194 calls to incidents in Alloa;

Beat A01 – 231 calls received for area leading from town towards Cambus.

Beat A02 – 509 calls received for area behind Tesco out towards Clackmannan

Beat A03 - 293 calls for town centre

Beat A04 – 161 calls received for area leading out towards Tullibody

Calls range from public looking for advice from Police, member of the public reporting drug related issues, disturbance, road traffic offences and concern for person. Not all calls result in a report(s) having to be submitted.

1 call received regarding issues around Redwell Primary, complaining about parking issue, 1 call from council looking for Police to cover school crossing patrol and 1 call about damage to a bike shelter.

210 calls relate to complaint of public nuisance at various locations, including complaints about buskers and beggars in the town centre.

96 calls recorded are specifically for Alloa Police Station, vast majority relating to people handing themselves into Police in respect of warrants, although recently large number of incidents created in line with the National air weapon campaign which runs until Sunday 12th June. So far Nationally 2000 air weapons have been surrendered.

RECORDED CRIME

428 crimes recorded 122 undetected 306 detected

Detection rate 71%, up 5% on last report

Beat A01 – 54 crimes recorded, 21 undetected, 33 detected.

Beat A02 – 225 crimes recorded, 62 undetected, 163 detected.

Beat A03 – 89 crimes recorded, 23 undetected, 66 detected.

Beat A04 – 60 crimes recorded, 16 undetected, 44 detected.

UPDATE - 6th March, a bogus workman related crime occurred in Hawkhill Road, Alloa, where a male managed to obtain a four figure sum of money. Male now identified for this incident and a report being submitted for this and other similar crimes within the Forth Valley division.

51 recorded theft by shoplifting crimes in Alloa, 9 currently undetected with enquiries still being made and 42 detected.

10th April, 15 year old youth charged in relation to a hate crime, after shouting and swearing at a transgender person.

20th April, 2 males reported after a 6 figure sum of money and a 5 figure sum of controlled drugs recovered.

25th April, 15 year old youth charged after robbing another teenager at Grange Road, Alloa.

8th May, a cannabis cultivation discovered at a local address. Male subject of a report.

20th May, a bogus workman incident occurred at a property in Redwell Place, where a five figure sum of jewellery was stolen. Various lines of enguiry are still ongoing.

ANY OTHER COMMUNITY ISSUES

Facebook and Twitter – Community Messages can be placed on local Police sites via Community Sergeant.

Parking in town centre still continues to be an ongoing issue.

On 29th April, a test purchase operation took place at a number of off sales. All premises passed. Clear that adults are buying alcohol for children.

On 27th May, an intelligence led licenced premises inspections took place in Alloa town centre. Drugs found at one of the premises and traces of drugs found at another.
