What is the Children's Rights Project?

The Children's Rights Project provides assistance to children and young people aged between 5 and 18 with issues such as:

- Children's Hearings
- School exclusions
- Educational Issues
- Bullying and Abuse

The project will focus on some key areas such as:

- Supporting children and young people who are eligible under the additional support for learning legislation.
- Helping children and Young people who are victims of bullying.
- Advising children who may enter the Children's Hearing system.
- Support with children who are school abstainers or have been excluded.
- Supporting young people during their transition to adulthood.
- Protecting children and young people from severely disadvantaged home backgrounds.
- Supporting the participation of children and young people in decision making.
