


## Parish Precept 2010/11

The Parish Council precept for 2010/11 will be £231,924. This will amount to around £56.18 per annum for a Band D Council Tax Payer, which represents an increase of 3.23%.

The majority of the money raised from the precept will be allocated to the revenue budget which funds the day to day costs of providing the Council services and amenities. The main areas of expenditure are indicated below



• Playground maintenance is mainly the cost of grass cutting and hedge maintenance

• Watercourses covers the maintenance and clearance of watercourses which flow across our Sports field and Playground areas

## Budget for 2010/11

• Admin + office costs include rates, utilities, insurance and consumables

 The loan repayment for the Council's office represents the fourth and final payment

• The Council employs a Clerk, two Clerical Assistants and two Caretakers (all part time)

• Unlike Borough and County Councillors, Parish Councillors give their time voluntarily and receive no paid allowances

• General Purposes includes the quarterly Newsletter and general maintenance activities

• The Sports Centre grant is to replace funding being withdrawn by TBC but will be subject to negotiation of a satisfactory service level agreement

• Grants and donations are also given for the Christmas Lights, the Carnival, the Roses Theatre, Youth Club for 12 and 13 year olds and to other local charities

• Your Council runs a Community Building, Sports field and Allotment site. The intent is that they should all be self-financing

 Community Building is completely funded by the income received including the cost of employing a Caretaker
