Introduction

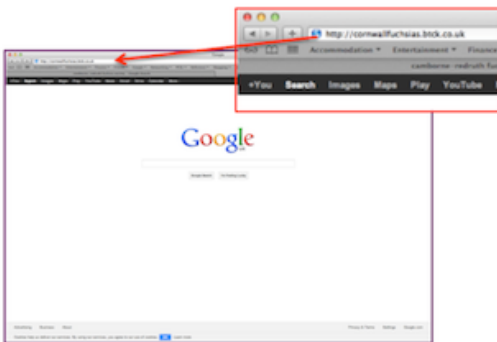

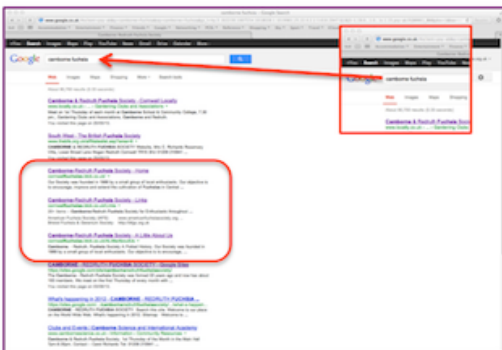
CRFS Website Homepage

Finding the CRFS Website

The URL or web address for the CRFS website is: <http://cornwallfuchsias.btck.co.uk>



If you enter this address into the web browser (e.g. Internet Explorer, Safari, etc) on your PC, it will take you to the homepage of the CRFS website.



If you haven't the web address handy, then a search in a browser such as Google should find us.

The Homepage



The homepage is the landing from which you can get the headlines and you can move to other pages on the CRFS website.

The list of pages you see on the homepage is repeated on every page, so to get back to the homepage click on "home".

If you have clicked on a link to another site and want to get back to the CRFS web site then click on the back arrow ◀ at the top of the page to backtrack.

Using Links to Go Exploring for More Information

Links, or hyperlinks as the technical folk call them, are paths to other websites and to sources of further information. As with the earlier illustration of the homepage, underlined text says that clicking on this word or these words will take you to another website and more information.

The Links page on the CRFS website will be expanded over time but already it is the gateway to a mine of information and entertainment.

You now know, if you didn't before, that things that are underlined will take you to more information, but clicking on names that are underlined will bring up an email for you to send.
