Witness appeal following A23 collision near Bolney

Police are appealing for witnesses following a collision between two vehicles on the A23 London Road near Bolney at around 4pm on Sunday (26 February).

Fortunately neither the driver of the bronze Kia, a 26-year-old man from Chichester, nor the driver of the black Mercedes, a 64-year-old man from Kent, were injured.

The road was blocked but reopened following recovery work at around 5.15pm. PC Richard Brand from the Sussex Police Roads Policing Unit said: "We are keen to hear from anyone who was on that stretch of road on Sunday afternoon and who saw what happened immediately before or after the collision.

"We'd especially like to hear from anyone with information about a white Range Rover or Land Rover which was seen nearby."
