Police are seeking the identity of this man after he allegedly spat at a bus driver in Horsham.

The bus driver was driving a Metro bus by the Park and Ride near Worthing Road, <u>Horsham</u>, around 5.25pm on Friday, 22 June when a man knocked on his window.

Despite the bus not being stopped at a designated bus stop, the man asked to be let onto the bus but the driver said no.

The man – described as medium build, in his late 20s and wearing an orange jacket - then spat at the driver through his open window and walked off.

Appeal for witnesses to a group assault in Horsham Park

Police are appealing for witnesses after a group were assaulted and possessions stolen in Horsham.

The group were sitting in <u>Horsham</u> Park around 10.25pm on Thursday (26 July) when they were approached by another group.

Both a verbal and physical altercation occurred and the suspects stole two of the victims' bags.

The main suspect is described as mixed race, 5' 10", aged between 16 and 24years-old and wearing a black hooded top.

The second main suspect is described as a white man, 5' 10" aged between 16 and 24-years-old, and he was topless.
