An update regarding the recent series of thefts from vehicles in Rudgwick:

Horsham Police are continuing to investigate a small series of thefts from vehicles in the Rudgwick area that occurred overnight on 6 -7 February 2015. On 22 February 2015 a 28 year old man from Brighton was arrested on suspicion of these offences and is currently on police bail while the investigation continues.

Sergeant Victoria Tomlinson said "Local Officers have been conducting a full and thorough investigation into these offences which has led to this positive arrest. The investigation is ongoing and we hope to achieve a positive result for the victims in due course"

Burglary Update - Broomfield Road, Henfield:

A burglary was reported to police on Monday 23 February at a property in Broomfield Road, Henfield after the occupant woke to find the living room window of his property open and his wallet missing. On 28 February a 16 year old boy from Henfield was arrested on suspicion of the offence and is currently on police bail.

Operation Tulip:

Horsham Neighbourhood Policing Team is launching Operation Tulip to tackle outdoor property theft in the Horsham District this spring. As the warmer weather arrives, the opportunities for thieves can increase with open windows, insecure sheds and gardening tools left out.

Horsham Neighbourhood Policing Team and members of Horsham District Neighbourhood Watch (NHW) are holding four 'come and meet us' sessions at local garden centres during March to speak to local residents, give out crime prevention and property marking advice and to promote NHW and immobilise.com
