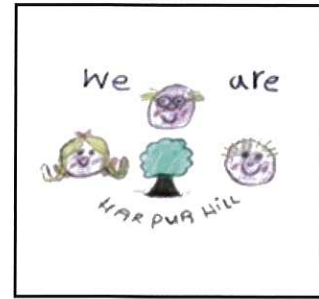

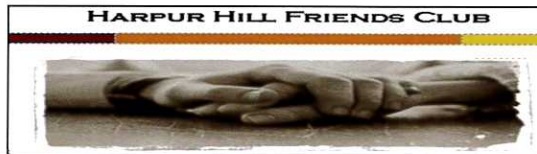
Held on the last Wednesday of every month in the Hoffman Bar, Harpur Hill.
