Lack of approaching bend sign on Whittlesey Road reported to Highways 7<sup>th</sup> March 2017. Reply received 22/03/17 "can you recall when the sign was last in place as it is not recorded on our inventory. Our records as far back as 2009 make no reference".

Request for information on the felling of 2 Lime Trees in St Marys Churchyard sent to FDC 7<sup>th</sup> March 2017. Reply received 10/03/17 "The two trees on inspection were rotten through the main trunk at approx. 3 to 5 metres from the ground, plus they had considerable dead wood in the crown of the tree, I deemed them unsafe and in need of urgent felling due to them being adjacent to the road where regular car parking for the river area is undertaken. We will look at two replacements next winter if budgets permit".

Email sent to FDC to advise of outstanding CAT1 street lights 7<sup>th</sup> March 2017. Reply received 13/03/17 "Balfour Beatty are aware that the completion of the Benwick CAT1 replacements remains outstanding and this will be addressed as part of the backlog clearance. Unfortunately they do not have a timetable for completing these works other that this is their priority."

Footpaths in the village have been highlighted to Highways as needing repair on 13<sup>th</sup> March 2017. *Reply received 22/03/17 "I will have a look at the pavements especially Lilyholt Road"*.
