## Major Roof Repairs - Update Number 3 - November 2023

Dominic Roberts, Conservation Architect and Project Manager for our roof repair is making good progress on appointing various building professionals to prepare a detailed plan of action for the work which is due to begin on site in April 2024.

Given the nature and historical importance of the church this is a complex operation which requires careful planning and liaison with various official bodies. The following work has now been undertaken:

• A Quantity Surveyor and a Structural Engineer have been appointed.

• An Asbestos Removal Architect has prepared a budget cost for the removal of the asbestos sheet ceiling. We are currently discussing access and scaffolding requirements.

• Mr Roberts is awaiting quotes from a roofing contractor for the investigation of the high number of broken slates so that we can make proposals for repair or replacement.

• A measured survey has been completed and the property group has been provided with working drawings which will be filed in the parish records for use on this and all future projects.

• Now that the measured survey is complete, we will work with the project manager and structural engineer on the design of roof repairs and the new ceiling.

• Information has been obtained regarding the VAT reclaim scheme for Listed and Historic Churches.

• Details of various grant awards are being obtained to support the high cost of this work. Further updates will be published as and when available.

## Pre-paid Grave Fees

You may be aware that the parish is currently running a scheme for parishioners and, in some limited circumstances non-parishioners, to pre-pay the fee for a grave plot in our parish churchyard. The scheme secures a plot for two people at the current rate of payment and avoids any unnecessary stress following a death.

This type of scheme is available in many parishes and, although it does not indicate a specific grave plot, it affords the family peace of mind in knowing that the grave fee has been paid prior to other funeral expenses occurred at the time of death. Following death, the next available grave plot is allocated, Accurate parish records are kept of the payment alongside the personal details of those involved. An official parish receipt and certificate of entitlement is given to the purchaser.

The cost of the grave would be charged in accordance with the parish charging policy at the time of purchase, currently £750, for regular worshipers and £3,000 for non-parishioners. The fee for the internment of ashes is currently £200. A full list of graveyard charges is posted at the back of church and on the parish website. Please note, these charges are due to rise significantly in March next year.

With this in mind, and at a time when our parish is struggling to raise significant funding to repair the church roof, it may be mutually beneficially for you to seriously consider pre-paying for a grave plot before prices are increased.
