- Day 1 We depart early to head south for our crossing to France. We arrive late afternoon at our hotel in Breda situated in the centre of this lovely town. After dinner, stroll into the centre enjoy a drink at one of the outdoor cafes.
- Day 2 After breakfast, we head to the city of cheese Gouda. Gouda has much more to offer than cheese alone. There are plenty of things to do and discover in this beautiful historic city full of trendy hotspots and passionate people. From The Markt, the central square with its iconic town hall to the beautiful stained-glass windows of the Sint-Jans church and from street food to the first Fairtrade street in the Netherlands, old and new meet and merge in Gouda. We also include admission to the Gouda Cheese Experience.
- Day 3 After a buffet breakfast, we head to the most beautiful Spring garden in the World. Keukenhof Gardens opens 8 weeks per year, displaying a staggering 7 million blooms. The site covers 80 acres of dazzling display. This rainbow carpet of flow is a riot of colour, set amongst shimmering lakes, ancient trees, flower shrubs and beautiful water gardens. The Dutch do know a thing or two about tulips the variety of flower and colours are overwhelming. There are restaurants located within the park.
- Day 4 This morning after breakfast, we bid farewell and retrace our steps to Calais for our afternoon sailing to the UK. We enjoy a lunch stop in Bruges, often described as the 'Venice of the North'. It is one of the best preserved medieval cities in Europe, with picturesque canals, intricate gabled houses, pretty narrow winding cobbled streets and bustling squares filled with many bars, cafes and restaurants.
